Women no longer safe in Goa, says MP

VASCO: Hitting out at the government for failing to ensure the safety of women in the State, Congress's South Goa MP Capt Viriato Fernandes alleged that today women are afraid to step out of their homes even during the day.

"There was a time in Goa, when women were safe even at night. If they were delayed due to work or a bus breakdown, no woman would have to worry about her safety. Today even if a woman leaves the house during the day, people at home are restive until they return home in the evening," Capt Fernandes said.

"Today if you walk in Panjim in the evening along the city waterfront on your way home, where all the casino jetties are lined up, people from Delhi and around the country are asking our women and girls how much they are available for. Is this what our women have to endure?" he asked.

Capt Fernandes was speaking at a block strengthening meeting organised by the Goa Pradesh Mahila Congress (GPMC) at Vasco, bringing together four blocks - Mormugao, Vasco, Cortalim and Dabolim - to discuss grassroots organisation and strategies ahead of the 2027 Assembly elections.

During the gathering, four new Block Mahila Congress Presidents were nominated. They are Shradha Kalangutkar (Vasco), Akshada Wadekar (Dabolim), Vinika Arolkar (Mormugao) and Lata Naik (Cortalim).

Prominent leaders present included Beena Naik (former GPMC President), Sneha Fondekar and Liberata Madeira (Vice Presidents), Adv Shabnam Khan (General Secretary), Mamta Maben and Mollie Da Gama Silva (District Presidents), Sangeeta Naik (South District Vice President) and Seema Behre (Executive Member).

Expressing grave concern over the rising crime against women in Goa, State Mahila Congress President Dr Pratiksha Khalap said, "Today, no woman is safe - whether it's a child, minor, senior citizen, doctor, teacher, pregnant woman or a mentally challenged lady. The law and order situation has completely collapsed under this government. It is time for every Mahila to unite and throw this corrupt and criminal government out in 2027."

PANJIM: A man sleeping on the promenade accidentally fell into the Mandovi River on Tuesday evening and drowned, despite rescue efforts by nearby locals.
Panjim Police suspect he may have been a visitor to an off-shore casino. His identity remains unknown and investigations are ongoing.

Bihar woman on holiday in Colva found dead in guest room
MARGAO: A 67-year-old woman from Bihar, who was at Colva on vacation with her family, was found unconscious in the guest room of a cottage and later declared brought dead at the South Goa District Hospital (SGDH), Margao. According to Colva police, they received a call from a local cottage informing them that a female guest was lying unconscious. Police rushed to the scene and immediately shifted her to SGDH, where doctors declared her brought dead. Enquiries revealed that the deceased had a history of medical illness. The family had travelled from Bihar for a vacation and were staying at a cottage in Colva. The woman had informed her family that she was tired and went to sleep. The next morning, her husband found her unresponsive and sought medical help. An inquest panchnama was conducted and the body was sent for post-mortem examination to ascertain the exact cause of death.

Andhra Pradesh businessman held for theft at Anjuna flat
PANJIM: An Andhra Pradesh-based businessman has been arrested by Anjuna Police for allegedly committing theft at a rented flat by entering through a sliding window. According to police, Raushan Ranjan, a native of Bihar, lodged a complaint stating that an unknown person had broken into his flat and stolen valuables, including a two mobile phones, AirPods and Rs 1,000 in cash. Following investigation, police identified and arrested the accused as 26-year-old Manchineni Santosh Kumar, a resident of Anantapur, Andhra Pradesh. One of the stolen mobile phones was recovered from his possession.

Man booked for rash driving after fatal accident in Orda-Candolim
PANJIM: A 24-year-old man, Sunil Pandappa Rathod, has been booked for rash and negligent driving after his car fatally knocked down a pedestrian in Orda-Candolim. The incident occurred on June 22, near Seval Temple, where the victim, Kesu Lamani of Bijapur, was seated by the roadside when he was struck by Rathod's vehicle. Lamani succumbed to his injuries. Following the incident, the victim's son, Kumar Lamani, filed a complaint with the local police.

Family escapes unhurt after coconut tree falls on house in Varca
MARGAO: A family narrowly escaped injury after a coconut tree fell on their house near the Bank of India at Novangully-Varca, Salcete. According to Station Fire Officer Gil Souza, the Margao Fire Station received an alert about the incident. The operation, led by S KG Dessai, took approximately one and a half hours to complete. While the estimated damage to the house was pegged at Rs 50,000, the fire personnel managed to save property worth around Rs 1 lakh.

Farmers urged to link Aadhaar-seeded bank details to Krishi cards
PANJIM: The Department of Agriculture has urged all farmers to link Aadhaar-seeded bank account details with their Krishi Cards to ensure seamless benefit disbursement through the Aadhaar Payment Bridge (APB) system. Farmers are required to submit a mandate form in the prescribed format along with a copy of their bank passbook or a cancelled cheque to the respective Zonal Agriculture Office. The APB system facilitates direct transfer of government subsidies and benefits to Aadhaar-linked bank accounts. The last bank account linked with the Aadhaar will be considered for subsidy deposits. Farmers must notify the Zonal Agriculture Office in case of changes to their Aadhaar-seeded bank accounts so that Krishi Card records can be updated accordingly.

HC quashes case against businessman

PANJIM: The High Court of Bombay at Goa on Monday quashed and set aside the FIR and subsequent chargesheet filed against Dnyaneshwar Govekar, a businessman from Caranzalem.
On July 15, 2023, the Panjim police had registered a case against Govekar under Sections 143, 447, 323, 504, 506 read with Section 149 of the IPC, 1860, and a corresponding chargesheet dated August 5, 2024.
The petitioner, in his criminal writ petition, stated that he had no knowledge of the criminal proceedings initiated against him until December 2024, when he received a letter from the Passport Office, Panjim, during the process of renewing his passport.
The FIR was lodged based on a complaint filed by Estonia Almeida, who alleged that on October 16, 2021, at Taleigao-Tiswadi, Govekar, along with others and with a common object, formed an unlawful assembly and criminally trespassed onto Almeida's property. It was further alleged that the petitioner abused labourers employed by the respondent for plastering work on the compound wall, and thereafter assaulted the respondent, causing bodily injuries.
However, the Court observed that no prima facie case was made out and stated that the continuation of the criminal proceedings would amount to an abuse of the process of law. Accordingly, the Court quashed and set aside the FIR and chargesheet filed before the JMFC, Panjim.
Advocate Rohit Bras De Sa appeared on behalf of Govekar.

Divar-Old Goa ferry services temporarily suspended

PANJIM: Ferry services between Divar and Old Goa were temporarily halted on Tuesday morning after the ferry ramp on the Divar side was submerged due to heavy rainfall and a high tide.
The flooding of the ramp during the monsoon season is a recurring issue faced by the islanders.
Residents of Divar voiced frustration over the lack of a lasting solution to this persistent problem. They pointed out that the low elevation of the ferry ramp and the roads leading to the island are the primary causes of the flooding.
"This happens every year," said Jerry De Souza, former panch of the Sao Mathias panchayat, while speaking to O Herald. "The problem is that the ramp is low and so are the roads. There is a need to increase their height and maintain them properly. Locals, especially the youth, should take initiative to see that things improve. Flooding also worsens when dam water is released. Once ferry service is stopped, it causes huge inconvenience to islanders."
