PANJIM: Goa's Michael Ryan Mare kept the State's hopes alive on Day 2 of the Yonex-Sunrise All India Sub Junior (U-13) Ranking Badminton Tournament organised by the Goa Badminton Association under the aegis of Badminton Association of India and the Sports Authority of Goa at Manohar Parrikar Indoor Stadium, Navelim, on Tuesday.

Michael, Goa's top ranked player, partnering Sai Char-

ith Abbu of Telangana won their Boys Doubles Round 2 match defeating Ajinkya Desai (Maharashtra) and Aadvik Sah (Uttarakhand) in a tight contest 17-15, 5-15, 15-9, to move into the next round.

Meanwhile, Goa's Samarth Sakhalkar continued his spirited run in the Boys Singles, edging out Venkat Sai Hishal Kaki (Telangana) 15-12, 15-17, 20-18 in a thrilling Round 3 match before going down to Milkha

Shinoy S (Kerala) 12-15, 9-15 in Round 4.

Other Goa players faced tough competition in the qualifiers. Vishwa Parab bowed out in Round 3 despite a strong start, losing

to Panshul Seth (Odisha) 15-10, 10-15, 12-15. Daksh Kamat was ousted by Maharashtra's Prathamesh Jagdale 7-15, 5-15. In Girls Singles, Amaira Dhumatker impressed again but was edged out in Round 3 by

Jiyashree R. (Tamil Nadu) 9-15, 8-15. Goa's Kanika Pai Vernekar too exited in Round 2, going down 7-15, 5-15 to Samanvitha Padamata (Andhra Pradesh). Goa's Boys Doubles pair Pratik Naik Borkar and Varun Sahakari lost 4-15, 4-15 to Advait Sattu and Advik Shukla of Telangana.

Among the top nationally ranked qualifying seeds, Kandarp Khatri (Uttar Pradesh) stunned second seed Kyon Tamin (Arunachal Pradesh) 13-15, 15-5, 15-10 in Boys Singles Round 4. Meanwhile, third seed Jatin Saraf (Maharashtra) powered past Pratham Sandeep Bayar (Karnataka) 15-6, 15-6, and fourth seed Kian Yadav (Rajasthan) crushed Abhiraj Singh (Uttarakhand) 15-2, 15-4.

In Girls Singles, top seed Twinkle Malik (Haryana) had a smooth passage into the next round, defeating Adyasha Lenka (Odisha) 15-8, 15-13. Padmja Singh (2) (Rajasthan) beat Tanya Nanubolu (Andhra Pradesh) 15-5, 6-15, 15-8, while third seed Vanya Choudhary (Uttar Pradesh) dismissed Kavya Vora (Gujarat) 15-2, 15-4. The main draws will start on Wednesday.

Miami, PSG progress to set up reunion

AFP, MIAMI: Inter Miami's Lionel Messi faces a tantalising reunion with former club Paris Saint-Germain in the Club World Cup last 16 after both sides on Monday progressed to the knockout phase.

Miami drew 2-2 with Palmeiras to go through second in Group A, after the Brazilian side fought back from two goals down to seal top spot.

They now face an all-Brazil clash against Botafogo, who lost 1-0 to Atletico Ma-

drid but progressed from Group B in second at the expense of the Spaniards.

Champions of Europe PSG won the group with a 2-0 victory over Seattle Sounders, paving the way for the clash with Messi and surprise package Miami. Goals from Tadeo Alende and Luis Suarez had Miami on course for a second victory in the tournament after their shock win over Porto. But Palmeiras struck twice in the last 10 minutes at Hard Rock Stadium through Paulinho and Mauricio to ensure they went through.

Within a remarkably short period, she not only honed her skills but also began participating actively in both State-level and All-India Civil Services Chess Tournaments.

Her breakthrough came in the State Civil Services Chess Tournament 2022-23, held at the Manohar Parrikar Indoor Stadium, Margao, where she competed in the open category alongside the men's team and earned selection to represent Goa. This achievement marked a proud and

Keeping up her remarkable streak, Akanksha competed in the 2024-25 State-Level Tournament held at Bahusahab Bandarkar Krida Sankul, Peddem Sports Complex, Mapusa, and subsequently participated in the All-India Civil Services Chess Tournament 2024-25 at the same venue. In the team events, she scored 4.5 out of 6 points, winning four consecutive games and securing a third place on the top board - a phenomenal achievement. She secured the Best Veteran Award (Gold), stated the Goa Chess Association press release.

Akanksha Ulhas Desai's journey is a shining example of how passion, perseverance, and commitment can lead to extraordinary accomplishments, even when started later in life. Her contribution has elevated the presence of women in civil services chess. She is working in Public Works department as a statistical assistant.
