Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Kharge said, "I can't read English well. His (Tharoor's) (English) language is very good, that's why we have made him a Congress Working Committee member."

"But I want to say that the people of the opposition together said they are with the Army that is fighting (during Operation Sindoor)... We (the Congress) said the country is paramount and we will work together (with the government). We said 'country first, party later'. Some people say 'Modi first, country later'. What can we do about that." he said.

On another question related to Tharoor's comments, Kharge said, "Whoever knows how to write, will write it, we do not

want to think about that. Our target is to maintain unity in the country, to ensure the security of the country. We will keep fighting for the country, there is no need to pay attention to anvone's words.'

Pressed further on the Thiruvananthapuram MP's comments, Kharge said Tharoor is speaking according to his will but "we do not want to keep harping on it as we are more concerned about how to save the country".

Tharoor, in an article published in on Monday, said Modi's energy, dynamism and willingness to engage remained a "prime asset" for India on the global stage but deserved greater backing.

His remarks were seen as likely to irk his Congress party and widen cracks in his ties with its leadership.

PTI, NEW DELHI: Four people died and three got injured in a fire that broke out at a five-storey building housing multiple manufacturing units in Rithala area of Delhi's Rohini, police said on Wednesday.

Sixteen fire tenders were rushed to the building, located in Rohini Sector-5 area, after the fire department received a call regarding a blaze there at around 7.30 pm on Tuesday, officials said.

Delhi Fire Services chief AtulGarg said the incident was reported from a premises located near Rithala Metro Station.

80 per cent burn injuries, and Virender (25) who sustained minor burns were rescued and taken to BSA Hospital, a fire-

fighter said. However, Nitin and Rakesh were later shifted

The cause of the fire is to RML Hospital for further treatment, he added.

At around 1.15 am on Wednesday, fire personnel recovered three charred bodies from the first floor, the officer said, adding that later another body was found.

The fire department officials said the blaze was brought under control on the lower floors by 6 am, but firefighting operations are still underway on the third and top floor due to heavy smoke.
