

For some it's 'Modi first, country later': Kharge's swipe at Tharoor

Want to think about that. Our target is to maintain unity in the country, to ensure the security of the country. We will keep fighting for the country, there is no need to pay attention to anyone's words."

Pressed further on the Thiruvananthapuram MP's comments, Kharge said Tharoor is speaking according to his will but "we do not want to keep harping on it as we are more concerned about how to save the country".

Tharoor, in an article published in on Monday, said Modi's energy, dynamism and willingness to engage remained a "prime asset" for India on the global stage but deserved greater backing.

His remarks were seen as likely to irk his Congress party and widen cracks in his ties with its leadership.

PTI, NEW DELHI: In a jibe at Congress leader Shashi Tharoor, party chief Mallikarjun Kharge on Wednesday said his party believes in "country first" mantra but for some it is "Modi first and country later".

Soon after Kharge's remarks at a press conference here, Tharoor put out a cryptic post on X in which there was an image of a bird with the caption -- "Don't ask permission to fly. The wings are yours. And the sky belongs to no one..."

Asked about Tharoor's article on Operation Sindoor outreach in which he praised

Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Kharge said, "I can't read English well. His ('Tharoor's') (English) language is very good, that's why we have made him a Congress Working Committee member."

"But I want to say that the people of the opposition together said they are with the Army that is fighting (during Operation

Sindoor)... We (the Congress) said the country is paramount and we will work together (with the government). We said 'country first, party later'. Some people say 'Modi first, country later'. What can we do about that," he said.

On another question related to Tharoor's comments, Kharge said, "Whoever knows how to write, will write it, we do not

Police, BSF seize huge quantity of ammunition from Mizoram

PTI, AIZAWL: The CID (Special Branch) of Mizoram

Police and Border Security Force (BSF) seized a huge quantity of live ammunition of 7.62 mm and arrested one person in Aizawl district, a police officer said on Wednesday.

Acting on a specific input the team launched a joint operation at Seling village about 36 km from state capital Aizawl on Tuesday and seized 3,008 live ammunition of 7.62 mm worth around Rs 16.54 lakh from a pickup truck, he said.

The driver of the pickup truck identified as

Lalawithanga (48), a resident of Zaungtui locality in Aizawl, was arrested for transporting the ammunition, he said.

The vehicle used for transporting the ammunition was also seized by the agencies in the presence of civil witnesses, he said.

A case has been registered under Arms Act at Bawngkawn police station in Aizawl in connection with the seizure, the police officer said.

Further investigation of the case is on, he added.

4 dead, 3 injured in fire at five-storey building in Delhi

PTI, NEW DELHI: Four people died and three got injured in a fire that broke out at a five-storey building housing multiple manufacturing units in Rithala area of Delhi's Rohini, police said on Wednesday.

Sixteen fire tenders were rushed to the building, located in Rohini Sector-5 area, after the fire department received a call regarding a blaze there at around 7.30 pm on Tuesday, officials said.

Delhi Fire Services chief Atulgarg said the incident was reported from a premises located near Rithala Metro Station.

The cause of the fire is yet to be determined, and further investigation is in progress. Search operations are still underway to ascertain if any one is still trapped debris. Police have so far recovered four charred bodies, officials said.

Initially, three injured - Nitin Bansal (31) and Rakesh (30), both with 80 per cent burn injuries, and Virender (25) who sustained minor burns - were rescued and taken to BSA Hospital, a firefighter said.

However, Nitin and Rakesh were later shifted

to RML Hospital for further treatment, he added.

At around 1.15 am on Wednesday, fire personnel recovered three charred bodies from the first floor, the officer said, adding that later another body was found.

The fire department officials said the blaze was brought under control on the lower floors by 6 am, but firefighting operations are still underway on the third and top floor due to heavy smoke.

Assistant Divisional Officer (ADO) of DFS Rajesh Kumar said that the cooling process is still underway.
