

AP, VENICE: This weekend's star-studded Venice wedding of multi-billionaire Amazon founder Jeff Bezos and Lauren Sanchez has galvanised activist groups that are protesting it as a sign of the growing disparity between the haves and have-nots as well as disregard of the city's residents.

About a dozen Venetian organisations - including housing advocates, anti-cruise ship campaigners and university groups - have united to protest the multi-day event under the banner "No Space for Bezos", a play on words also referring to the bride's recent space flight.

They have staged smallscale protests, unfurling anti-Bezos banners on iconic Venetian sites. They
