# LAND GRAB KINGPIN'S FINGERPRINT ON MULTIPLE **ATTACHED PROPERTIES**

Mutations already done for many properties linked to arrested fraudster Md Sohail; why is SIT silent on probe into land grab crimes, ask activists

PANJIM: The Enforcement Directorate (ED) has blown the lid off the extensive network of alleged land grab kingpin Mohammad Sohail, linking him to 14 of the 24 immovable properties provisionally attached in the probe into Goa's widening land grab scandal. Sohail was arrested by the Crime Branch in Quepem on June 12.

Sohail is alleged to be involved in fraudulent activities connected to over 92 properties across North Goa. He has since applied for bail.

According to ED findings, mutations of five out of the 14 provisionally attached properties have already been fraudulently processed. Notably, the mutation of Custodian of Enemy Property under Survey No 540/13 was completed within just two days.

Police arrest alumnus, 2 others

KOLKATA: 24-year-old first-year student of a law college in south Kolkata was gang-raped inside the institution allegedly by an alumnus and its two senior students, police said on Friday.

All three accused were arrested and produced before a court which remanded them to police custody for four days.

Results of the medical examination conducted

on the victim corroborated her gang-rape allegation, a senior Kolkata Police officer said.

The incident prompted fierce responses from opposition parties, with the Left, BJP, Congress and AIDSO supporters clashing with the police outside the Kasba police station under whose jurisdiction the alleged crime was committed.

## CM Pramod Sawant to head Kala **Academy**

PANJIM: Chief Minister Pramod Sawant has been appointed Chairperson of the Kala Academy with immediate effect, as per an order issued by the Governor on Friday. The position was previously held by MLA Govind Gaude, who served in the role by virtue of being the Minister for Art and Culture.

The official order stated: "In exercise of the power conferred by clause 5 of the constitution of Kala Academy, Panaji-Goa, Dr Pramod Sawant, Hon'ble Chief Minister shall act as Chairperson of Kala Academy, Panaji-Goa with immediate effect till further order."

The development comes on the heels of CM Sawant dropping Govind Gaude from the State cabinet on June 18, ending speculation regarding his continuation as Minister for Art and Culture, Sports Affairs, and the Rural Development Agency.

# Raj, Uddhav reunite over language

PTI, MUMBAI: Estranged cousins Uddhay and Rai Thackeray will unite for the cause of the Marathi language, as their parties will stage a joint protest against the 'imposition' of Hindi and the state government's three-lan guage formula for Classes 1-5.

The protest on July 5 will bring Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray and Maharashtra Navnirman Sena (MNS) president Raj Thackeray on the same platform.

Both leaders had asserted on Thursday that they would vehemently oppose the imposition of Hindi and the three-language formula while addressing separate press conferences at the same time.

Uddhav had announced to join a protest by civil society at Azad Maidan on July 7, while Raj declared that he would take out a non-political march from Girgaum Chowpatty on July 6, and would invite leaders of all political outfits, including the Shiv Sena (UBT).

Talking to reporters on Friday, Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Sanjay Raut said Raj invited him to take part in the July 6 protest.

Sanvordem Panchayat orders removal of crusher after public outcry and O Heraldo reports

GUDDEMOL, SANVORDEM: After public outrage and a series of reports by O Heraldo, the Sanvordem Village Panchayat has finally ordered the removal of an illegal crusher plant in the area.

The plant, constructed at Survey Number 8/1 in Guddemol, was controversially built over a natural nallah and within 15 metres of a State Highway, raising a number of environmental and regulatory concerns.

Sarpanch Chinmayi Naik confirmed the Panchayat's decision, noting that the owner of the crusher has agreed to dismantle the plant and clear the site. "However, by the time we went for inspection, the entire crusher was already underwater due to heavy rains," Naik stated. "We then told the crusher owner to remove all machinery immediately, and he himself assured



that it would be done." Originally granted only pro-

visional approval, the crusher's owner proceeded with full-scale operations, including unauthorised land-filling and tree cutting. The violations were first brought to light through O Heraldo's reporting in collaboration with local activist Swapnil Bhandari.

The construction's proximity to the highway and its sitting over a nallah prompted swift backlash from the local community.

A joint inspection by the Panchavat, Town and Country Planning Department, and other authorities resulted in a stay order.

# **ACB** moves HC in Madkaikar FIR row

### **Argues in High Court that** Sessions Judge lacked jurisdiction to direct FIR registration

PANJIM: The Anti-Corruption Branch (ACB) of Vigilance has filed a criminal revision petition before the High Court of Bombay at Goa, challenging a Sessions Court order directing it to register an FIR based on statements made by former Minister Pandurang Madkaikar, and to proceed in accordance with the law regarding alleged corruption.

The Sessions Court (Special Court), Panjim, had passed the directive in response to a complaint related to Madkaikar's public claim made on March 4 this year, where he had stated that he paid around Rs 15-20 lakh to get his file cleared, and alleged that all Ministers are "busy count-

ing money." The complaint was filed

by activists Kashinath Shetye, Sudip Tamankar, and others, who sought an investigation and legal action against the individuals allegedly implicated by Madkaikar's statements.

In its petition, the ACB informed the High Court that it conducted a preliminary inquiry and recorded the statements of Madkaikar and Vishnu Tivrekar. According to the ACB, both clarified that the amount referred to was meant for payment to the government treasury as fees for land conversion. Additionally, a fine was levied on Madkaikar's company by the North Goa Collector for constructing a road without the required permissions — this amount too, they said, was paid to the government.
