Over 4,400 Indian nationals evacuated from Iran

19 special flights used so far under Operation Sindhu: MEA

PTI, NEW DELHI: India has evacuated more than 4,400 Indian nationals from Iran and Israel so far in 19 special flights under Operation Sindhu launched on June 18 to bring home its citizens amid the ongoing conflict between the two countries, according to the Ministry of External Affairs.

A fresh batch of 173 Indians evacuated from Iran reached Delhi late Thursday night in a flight from Armenian capital Yerevan, the MEA said in a post on X. At his weekly media briefing a day before, External Affairs Ministry spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal, in response to queries on Operation Sindhu, said New Delhi was assessing the situation on the ground and a decision on the future course of action would be taken based on it.

Over 3,400 Indian nationals have been evacuated so far in 14 flights from Iran since the start of Operation Sindhu, according to data shared by him during the briefing. Jaiswal later shared updated evacuee figures in the post on X after the arrival of

the flight from Yerevan. "A special evacuation flight from Yerevan, Armenia landed in New Delhi at 22:30 hrs on 26th June, bringing home 173 Indian nationals from Iran," he wrote. "As part of #OperationSindhu, a total of 4415 In-

dian nationals (3597 from Iran and 818 from Israel) have been evacuated so far using 19 special evacuation flights including 3 IAF aircraft. 14 OCI card-holders, 9 Nepali nationals, 4 Sri Lankan nationals and 1 Iranian spouse of an Indian national were also evacuated from Iran," he added.

On June 24, India said while it remained "deeply concerned about the prospects for overall and sustained regional security and stability", it welcomed reports of a ceasefire between Iran and Israel. Hours after US President Donald Trump's claims of an Iran-Israel ceasefire, the MEA in a statement had said "India stands ready to play its part" to resolve the situation and insisted on "dialogue and diplomacy" as the way forward.

Man injured as elephant runs amok during Rath Yatra in Ahmedabad

PTI, AHMEDABAD: One person was injured on Friday during the Rath Yatra procession in Ahmedabad, when a male elephant, agitated by excessive noise, broke a barricade and rushed into a narrow lane, officials said.

The mahouts on two other elephants followed the jumbo and controlled it, ensuring that the procession proceeded smoothly on its designated route, said RK Sahu, superintendent of Kankaria Zoo in the city. "One bystander was injured after an elephant got disturbed and entered a narrow lane in the Khadia area. The injured person has been shifted to a nearby hospital. The procession is going ahead as scheduled," said Deputy Commissioner of Police (Control Room) Komal Vyas.

The 148th Rath Yatra of Lord Jagannath began in Ahmedabad on Friday morning, with thousands of devotees joining the annual event. The grand procession, which rolled on from the 400-year-old Jagannath temple, is expected to return by 8 pm after making

its way through the old city. The procession usually has 17 elephants, 100 trucks, and 30 akhadas (local gymnasiums). It covers 16 km during the day. Only one among these elephants is male, said Sahu, who is responsible

for checking the health of these elephants and issuing fitness certificates ahead of the event. "When the procession reached Khadia Gate, the male elephant suddenly got agitated due to loud music and whistle sounds. It start-

Illegal gun factory busted in Bihar

PTI, BIHAR SHARIF: An illegal "mini gun factory" was busted in Nalanda district of Bihar, police said.

A young couple was arrested with arms and ammunition, including a "made in USA" pistol, from the premises, police said. According to a statement issued by the district police, a raid was conducted at a house in Soharsai locality of Bihar Sharif town, where Nalanda is headquartered, following a tip-off.

A case has been registered against the couple and further investigation is underway.

Punjab Police busts Pak ISI-backed terror module, nabs three

PTI, CHANDIGARH: Punjab Police Friday said they have busted a Pakistan's Inter-Services Intelligence (ISI)-backed terror module named Babbar Khalsa International with the nabbing of three people, including a juvenile.

State police chief Gaurav Yadav claimed the group was conspiring to carry out attacks on police establishments and targeted killings in the Amritsar area. "A major terror plot has been foiled, saving countless innocent lives," the director general of police (DGP) said.

In a post on X, Yadav said, "In an intelligence-led op-

eration, the State Special Operation Cell, Mohali has successfully busted a Pak ISI-backed Babbar Khalsa International terror module, being operated by UK-based Nishan Singh and Pakistan-based terrorist Harwinder Rinda. Three associates, including a juvenile, have been arrested."

"During the operation, two hand grenades, one pistol, and ammunition were recovered. The nabbed accused have been identified as Sehaipal Singh and Vikramjit Singh, both residents of Ramdas in Amritsar Rural, along with a juvenile," he said.

Amethi: Soil, salt found mixed in free ration food grains, FIR ordered after probe

PTI, AMETHI (UP): A major irregularity has come to light in Uttar Pradesh's Amethi where bags of food grain, meant to be distributed under the free ration scheme for the poor, were allegedly found mixed with soil and salt, officials said.

The allegation was confirmed during an on-site investigation by District Magistrate Sanjay Chauhan, who has now ordered that an FIR be lodged against those responsible.

During the inspection, food grains and their bags were checked, and initial

findings revealed lumps of soil and salt mixed in with the grains. In response, the DM directed the district supply officer and the district food and marketing officer to immediately replace the adulterated grains with clean supplies.

He also ordered a

high-level probe to be conducted by a joint team headed by the Additional District Magistrate (Finance and Revenue), including the district supply officer, district food and marketing officer, and the local sub-divisional magistrate.

E-rickshaw driver who ferried school kids held for sharing child pornography videos

INDORE: An electric rickshaw driver who ferried school kids in his three-wheeler in Indore has been arrested for allegedly sharing child pornography videos, a police official said on Friday. The 60-year-old man had shared three porn clips involving children through WhatsApp, said inspector Dinesh Verma of the cyber squad of police. To deceive the investigators, the accused had formatted his mobile phone, but the police used technology to recover the deleted objectionable visuals that he had sent to other people, the official said. The accused used to pick up students from their homes, take them to a school in the city, and drop them back in his e-rickshaw, he said.

Maharashtra logs 13 new COVID-19 cases, one death

MUMBAI: Maharashtra on Friday recorded 13 new cases of COVID-19, which took the tally of infections to 2,462, and one death, the health department said. A 65-year-old woman suffering from comorbidities, including rheumatoid arthritis, died in Kolhapur, an official said. Since January 1, the state has recorded 2,462 COVID-19 cases and 37 deaths, the department said. Of the fresh cases, five were reported from Pimpri Chinchwad, three from Nagpur, two from Pune and one each from Thane, Navi Mumbai, and Satara, an official statement said. The health department has conducted 28,486 COVID-19 tests across the state since January 1, and 2,277 patients have recovered from the infection till date, it said. Mumbai has reported 980 cases, including 539 in June alone, so far this year. At least 37 patients have succumbed to the virus in the state since January 1, of whom 36 had comorbidities (pre-existing health conditions that can increase the risk of severe illness), the statement said.

E-rickshaw driver shot at over vehicle brushing incident in Delhi, 1 held

NEW DELHI: A man has been arrested for alleged shooting at an e-rickshaw driver after he accidentally brushed his vehicle against a car in Delhi's Nand Nagri area, police said on Friday. In the early hours of June 23, Vinay (30) was on going back to his home in Saboli from Amit Vihar in his e-rickshaw. As he took an about-turn near Gagan Cinema, his vehicle reportedly brushed against a black car, a senior police officer said. In a fit of rage, the SUV driver, identified as Sameer Sharma (46), allegedly pulled out a pistol and shot at Vinay before fleeing the spot, he added. A PCR call regarding the gunshot injury was received from GTB Hospital, where the victim was admitted for treatment, the police said.

Thunderstorms, gusty winds likely in Andhra for next five days: IMD

AMARAVATI: The India Meteorological Department (IMD) on Friday forecast thunderstorms accompanied by lightning and gusty winds across several regions of Andhra Pradesh over the next five days. According to the IMD, isolated places in North Coastal Andhra Pradesh (NCAP), Yanam, South Coastal Andhra Pradesh (SCAP), and Rayalaseema are likely to experience gusty winds reaching speeds of 40-50 kmph. "Thunderstorms accompanied by lightning are likely at isolated locations across NCAP, Yanam, SCAP, and Rayalaseema during the forecast period," said a press release. The weather activity is expected to intensify from June 28 to July 1, with strong surface winds particularly affecting SCAP and Rayalaseema. Coastal belts may also witness brief periods of heightened wind speeds.

UP: 19 arrested for gambling in Pratapgarh; cash, jewellery recovered

PRATAPGARH (UP): In a late-night raid, the police here arrested 19 individuals for gambling and recovered cash, gold and silver jewellery, mobile phones, and vehicles, officials said on Friday. The joint operation was conducted by the Kotwali Nagar police and the cyber cell team led by SHO Neeraj Kumar Yadav and cyber cell in-charge Vindhyaavasinii Tiwari, Additional Superintendent of Police Shailendra Lal said. The raid occurred on the night of June 26-27 at a house located behind the Kashiram Colony near Saroj Chauraha. The accused were caught gambling on the premises. The arrested individuals were identified as Akbar Amir Khan, Gyanendra Bahadur, Atul Singh, Puneet Kumar Ojha, Arvind Kumar Singh alias Ketan Singh, Maan Bahadur alias Munna, Vimal Tiwari, Sandeep Soni alias Shani, Sonu Singh, Manish Verma alias Monu, Atul Singh, Bhishkek Singh, Ramchandra Soni, Nagendra Kumar, Satyam Singh alias Gandhi, Sudhir Tripathi, Paras Nath, Sahab Singh, and Rohit Patel, the officer stated.
