Elusive leopard trapped in cage in Kerala village

WAYANAD: A leopard that has been causing panic among residents of Kalloor, a forest-fringe area in this district, was trapped in a cage set by wildlife officials early on Tuesday. Villagers expressed relief as the forest officials were informed and reached the spot after the animal was caught. The leopard's presence had been reported in Cheeral and Nambiarkunnu areas on the Kerala-Tamil Nadu border here for the past few days, according to forest authorities. The villagers complained that the big cat was responsible for killing several domestic animals in recent days. A video, in which a leopard was seen walking alongside a road in the area, also surfaced a few days back.

Revised one-time tax slabs set to make high-end vehicles costlier in Maharashtra

MUMBAI: High-end cars, CNG/LNG vehicles and goods carriers in Maharashtra are set to become more expensive from Tuesday due to the revised one-time tax structure of the state government, officials said. The cap for one-time tax will now be Rs 30 lakh, against the existing Rs 20 lakh, which means cars with an ex-showroom price of more than Rs 20 lakh will get costlier by at least Rs 10 lakh, they said. High-end diesel and petrol cars registered under an individual's name, with prices around Rs 1.33 crore and Rs 1.54 crore, respectively, will now attract more than Rs 20 lakh in one-time tax, RTO officials said on Monday.

Gas leakage from tanker reported in Jharkhand

JAMSHEDPUR: Vehicular movement was affected on the Baharagora-Baripada national highway on Tuesday after gas leakage from a tanker was reported in Jharkhand's East Singhbhum district, officials said. The district administration stopped traffic movement on the highway this morning, following the report of Propylene gas leakage from the tanker near Jamsola, over 90 km from here, they said. On receiving the information about the gas leakage from the tanker near a petrol pump in Jamsola, the DC asked officials concerned to stop the movement of vehicles on the highway that connects East Singhbhum with Odisha's Baripada. The district administration swung into action as per the direction of Deputy Commissioner Karn Satyarthi.

Civil servants to go on 'mass leave' from Jul 1 to protest assault of senior colleague

BHUBANESWAR: The Odisha Administrative Service Association on Monday said its members will go on a 'mass leave' from Tuesday to protest against the alleged assault of a senior OAS officer. The decision in this regard was taken at a meeting of the association chaired by its president Jyoti Ranjan Mishra here. OAS officer and Bhubaneswar Municipal Corporation (BMC) Additional Commissioner Ratnakar Sahoo was allegedly dragged from his office and assaulted by a group of miscreants on Monday, police said.

Fire breaks out in four-storey building in Delhi's Seelampur area

NEW DELHI: A fire broke out in a four-storey building in Delhi's Seelampur area early on Tuesday. However, no casualty has been reported. According to an official of the Delhi Fire Services, the department received a call at 2.32 am, informing about fire in a building in Chauhan Banger. The authorities rushed seven fire tenders to the spot. The building had a jeans showroom on the ground floor and rest floors were residential. The fire was controlled by 8.05 am, the officer said.

Bengaluru: 260 cases lodged, 98 auto for overcharging

BENGALURU: In a crackdown against autorickshaws overcharging and plying illegally, Karnataka transport department authorities on Monday registered 260 cases and seized 98 vehicles. The action came days after state Transport Minister Ramalinga Reddy directed the transport commissioner to take strict action against app-based and other autorickshaws in Bengaluru that charge fares above the government-fixed rates, calling the practice a 'daylight robbery'. In a letter dated June 28, the minister said the permits of such autorickshaws should be cancelled and cases registered against the violators.

CBI takes over Sivaganga custodial death probe amid opposition outrage

PTI, CHENNAI/SIVAGANGA: The CBI will now probe the sensational Sivaganga custodial death case, in which five policemen have been arrested for murder, a DSP placed under suspension and a district police chief put on compulsory wait, following a Tamil Nadu government order. Amid widespread outrage and criticism, and opposition demand for a CBI probe, Chief Minister M K Stalin on Tuesday ordered transferring to the central agency, the investigation into death of Ajithkumar

(29), who was picked up by a "special team" for interrogation in connection with a theft case. The CM said he was anguished to know that Ajithkumar, picked up for enquiry died under mysterious circumstances in Tirupuvanam "only because of the assault by the police during interrogation."

"This is unjustifiable and cannot be excused," he said in a statement. While initially six policemen were suspended, five were later arrested for murder charge. The district SP has been put on compulsory wait while a DSP has been suspended, he recalled. He said he spoke to the family of the deceased and assured them of a honest and transparent probe to ensure their justice. "The Madras High Court Madurai bench has allowed the CB-CID probe into the matter. However, with five

policemen facing allegations, to ensure there are no apprehensions over the probe, I have directed transferring the investigation into the matter to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI)," Stalin said. The state government will

extend full cooperation to the CBI, he added. The matter also came up before the Madras High Court bench in Madurai, which appointed an Enquiry Officer to look into the issue and submit a report on July 8, while allowing a CB-CID probe into the case.

SC introduces reservation for apex court staff

PTI, NEW DELHI: In a first, the Supreme Court has introduced a formal reservation policy for the direct appointment and promotion of its staffers belonging to scheduled castes and scheduled tribes. The decision was communicated in a circular issued on June 24 to all Supreme Court employees. As per the directions of the Competent Authority, it is to notify for the information of all concerned that the Model Reservation Roster and Register has been uploaded on the Supnet (internal email network) and it is made effective from June 23, 2025. As per the circular and the model roster now in effect, top court employees will receive a 15 per cent quota and ST employees a 7.5 per cent quota in promotions.

8 killed in crackers factory blast in TN

PTI, VIRUDHUNAGAR: At least eight workers, including two women, were killed in a sudden blast at a firecracker manufacturing unit in Chinnakamanpatti near Sivakasi and police are inquiring into the incident. The deceased have been identified as R Mahalingam, C Chellapandian, K Lakshmi, R Ramamurthy, R Punyamurthy, K Ramajayam, M Nagapandi, and G Vairamani. Five persons are undergoing treatment at the Government Hospitals in Sivakasi and Madurai. Expressing 'shock' and grief over the tragic incident that happened at 8.30 am, the chief minister said he has ordered the officials to provide a solatium of Rs 4 lakh each to the families of the deceased.

Kolkata college gangrape: Custody of 3 accused extended till July 8

PTI, KOLKATA: The police custody of the three accused in the alleged gang rape of a first-year student at a law college in south Kolkata's Kasba area was extended by eight days till July 8 by a city court on Tuesday. The accused comprise the prime suspect, Monojit Mishra, an alumnus and temporary college staffer, and two current students, Zaib Ahmed and Pramit Mukherjee. They were arrested on June 26 and produced before the Alipore court, which initially remanded them to four days of police custody ending on Tuesday. The custody of the college security guard and the fourth accused, Pinaki Banerjee, who was arrested on Saturday in connection with the case and remanded in police custody till Tuesday, was extended till July 4. The authorities of South Calcutta Law College where the alleged crime took place, meanwhile, terminated the

CALCUTTA LAW COLLEGE EXPELS ACCUSED PTI, KOLKATA: The authorities of South Calcutta Law College terminated the services of the prime accused and expelled two other co-accused in the alleged gang rape of a 24-year-old student from the institute, an official said on Tuesday. The appointment of prime accused Monojit Mishra, who was serving as a casual employee of the college on a previous recommendation of its governing body, was cancelled in the wake of his arrest in connection with the crime. Mishra, along with co-accused Zaib Ahmed and Pramit Mukherjee, both students of the college, were arrested and remanded in police custody. Following a meeting of the college's governing body chaired by Trinamool Congress MLA Ashok Kumar Deb, the authorities announced the termination of Mishra's services and the expulsion of the two students.

Mishra was serving as a casual employee of the college on a previous recommendation of the college governing body which met on Tuesday to finalise the disciplinary measures. Police, while quoting doctors who examined the accused, said that investigation updates into the crime revealed evidence of scratch marks on the body of Mishra.

New species of flowering plant found in Arunachal

PTI, ITANAGAR: Forest officials in Arunachal Pradesh have discovered a new species of flowering plant, Begonia nyshiorum, in the high-altitude forests of East Kameng district. The species was documented during a challenging expedition by the Seppa Forest Division. Its discovery was recently published in the prestigious international journal Novon: A Journal for Botanical Nomenclature, on June 23. Named in honour of the Nyishi tribe, the largest in the northeastern state, the plant stands out for its unique crimson-fringed petioles, an identifying feature not seen in any other Asian Begonia, sources at the state forest department said. Chief Minister Pema Khandu lauded the Seppa Forest Division for the discovery, calling it a proud moment for Arunachal

Pradesh and a reaffirmation of the state's rich ecological legacy and global relevance in biodiversity. The plant now joins the expanding list of rare flora endemic to the Eastern Himalayan region, further highlighting the area's immense biodiversity. This discovery also underscores the pressing need for continued conservation and scientific research in one of India's most ecologically rich regions.
