# **Trump threatens to deport Musk**



AFP. WASHINGTON: Donald Trump and Elon Musk reignited their bitter feud Tuesday, with the US president threatening to deport the tech tycoon and strip federal funds from his businesses for criticizing Trump's flagship spending bill.

The world's richest person was Trump's biggest political donor in the 2024 election, and became his inseparable ally during his first months back in the White House as head of the Department of Government Efficiency (DOGE).

But the Space X and Tesla boss is now threatening to turn his riches against Trump, mulling a rival political party to challenge Republican lawmakers who vote for the president's "One Big Beautiful Bill."

Trump, 79, reacted vengefully on Tuesday as he headed to the opening of a new migrant detention center in Florida dubbed "Alligator Alcatraz."

"We'll have to take a look," he told reporters when asked if he would consider deporting Musk,

who has held US citizenship since 2002.

Trump also signaled that he could take aim at the huge contracts and subsidies that Musk's Space X rocket and Starlink satellite internet businesses receive from the US government.

"We might have to put DOGE on Elon. You know what DOGE is? DOGE is the monster that might have to go back and eat Elon," Trump said.

Trump added later in Florida: "I don't think he should be playing that game with me."

In reply to a post on his X social network featuring Trump's deportation comments, Musk said on Tuesday: "So tempting to escalate this. So, so tempting. But I will refrain for now."

Shares of Tesla sank around five percent Tuesday after Trump's threats. The tycoon and the

president shared a brief but intense bromance after Trump's return to power in January.

Wearing MAGA baseball hats, Musk was an almost constant presence at Trump's side.

# Yunus urges Bangladeshis to resist re-emergence of autocracy We will observe this every year so that we do not

PTI, DHAKA: Bangladesh's interim government chief Muhammad Yunus on Tuesday urged his countrymen to resist the re-emergence of autocracy as he launched a month-long programme to mark last year's mass protests that ousted longtime prime minister Sheikh

Hasina. 'We will observe this (July Uprising) every year so that we do not have to wait 16 years for another uprising again. We will do this every year so that we can destroy it immediately if there is any sign of dictatorship,' he said.

Yunus said the celebration was not just a matter of emotion or expression of outrage but rather a manifestation of vigilance so the autocracy or dictatorship could be gouged 'before it even shows its first leaf'.

He said throughout July and August, the celebration would revive every day of the last year for which the young students, commoners, rickshaw pullers, and workers were martyred and injured.

cannot raise its head again in any way,' Yunus said.

The movement started in July last year under a platform called Students against Discrimination (SAD), demanding reforms in a controversial quota system for government jobs, but turned violent, resulting in the ouster of the government on August 5, 2024, when Hasina left the country for India on a military aircraft.

Yunus flew from Paris three days later to take charge as the interim government's Chief Adviser as the SAD nominee. He subsequently disbanded Awami League and its students' front, saying the ban would remain enforced until their leaders were tried.


Most leaders of the Awami League and ministers of the past regime, including several officials. were arrested or were on the run at home and abroad as the government initiated their trial for brutal actions to tame the uprising, leaving several hundred people, including students, dead.

Hasina and her regime leaders are being prosecuted in Bangladesh's International Crimes Tribunal (ICT-BD), formed in 2010 for trying hardened collaborators of Pakistani troops during the 1971 Liberation War on charges like crimes against humanity.

According to a UN rights office report, some 1,400 were killed between July 15 and August 15, 2024, as retaliatory violence continued even after the fall of the past regime.

AFP. MOSCOW: Ukrain- erupt from the roof of a ian drones attacked the Russian city of Izhevsk on Tuesday, killing three people and wounding dozens in one of the deepest strikes inside Russia of the three-year conflict, authorities said.

Izhevsk, more than 1,000 kilometres (620 miles) from the front line, has arms production facilities including factories that make attack drones and the world-famous Kalashnikov rifle.

A Ukraine security services source said Kviv had targeted an Izhevsk-based drone manufacturer and that the attack had disrupted Moscow's "offensive po-

The region's head said the drones hit an industrial "enterprise", without giving detail.

"Unfortunately, we have three fatalities. We extend our deepest condolences to their families," Alexander Brechalov, head of the Udmurt Republic, where Izhevsk is located, wrote on Telegram.

"I visited the victims in the hospital. At the moment, 35 people have been hospitalized, 10 of whom are in serious condition." Russian forces in turn

### Pak, India exchange lists of prisoners in each other's custody

PTI, ISLAMABAD: Paki- Islamabad, the Foreign stan and India on Tuesday exchanged the lists of prisoners in each other's custody, with Islamabad submitting names of 246 Indian believed-to-be-Indian detainees, including 53 civilians and 193 fishermen.

The Agreement on Consular Access, 2008 requires both sides to share the lists of prisoners in each other's custody on January 1 and July 1, every year, according to a statement by the Foreign Office.

Pakistan handed over a list of 246 Indian or believed-to-be-Indian prisoners (53 civilian prisoners and 193 fishermen) to a representative of the Indian High Commission,

Office said.

'Today, Pakistan and India exchanged, through diplomatic channels, the lists of prisoners in each other's custody,' the FO said.

Simultaneously, shared a list of 463 Pakistani or believed-to-be-Pakistani prisoners (382 civilian prisoners and 81 fishermen) to a diplomat from the High Commission for Pakistan, New Delhi.

Pakistan has called for the immediate release and repatriation of all those Pakistani prisoners and fishermen who have completed their respective sentences and whose national status stands confirmed.

### **International Criminal** Court targeted by eyber attack

The ICC, which also was hit by a cyberattack in 2023, said the latest incident had been contained but did not elaborate further on the impact or possible motive.




