Minor boy pushes teen to death from Mumbai building

MUMBAI: Police have registered a murder case against a minor boy after he allegedly pushed to death a 15-yearold girl from the terrace of a building in Mumbai and tried to pass it off as a suicide, an official said. The 16-yearold accused and the victim were friends. The girl was a student of an international school and resided with her mother in Mulund area. On June 24, the girl arrived at a housing society in Bhandup (West) area to meet the boy and discussed her academic stress with him, the Bhandup police official said on Tuesday. The boy then took her atop a water tank on the terrace of the building's D-wing. While they were chatting, their conversation turned into a heated argument about dating, the official said.

Medical college student beaten up by seniors, video goes viral

BHOPAL: A case has been registered here after a video showing some students of a private medical college here thrashing a junior student went viral on social media, police said on Wednesday. The incident took place on Monday evening, said Nishatpura police station in-charge Rupesh Dubey, adding that no arrest has been made yet. The complainant, a third year student of People's Medical College, was allegedly beaten up by Paras Jain and two others after Jain accused the complainant of sending objectionable messages to his family, the official said. While a First Information Report (FIR) was registered under relevant sections of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita for assault, the accused also filed a counter-complaint of assault against the victim, he said.

Siddaramaiah says he will be Karnataka CM for 5 years

PTI, CHIKKABALLAPU-RA: Karnataka Chief Minister Siddaramaiah on Wednesday asserted that he will be in office for a full five-vear term.

He said that the Congress party was united and the party's government will be in power 'solid as a rock' for five years.

'Yes, I will be. Why do you have the doubts?' Siddaramaiah said in response to a question by reporters whether he will be the CM for five years.

There has been speculation within political circles, especially within the ruling Congress, for some time now about the Chief Minister change later this year, citing power-sharing agreement involving Siddaramaiah and Deputy Chief Minister D K Shivakumar.

consensual sex with survivor, cliams counsel

PTI, KOLKATA: The counsel of Monojit Mishra, prime accused in the gangrape of a student of a city-based law college, on Wednesday claimed that his client had "consensual sex" with the victim and that he was "framed" for a crime of which there are "no video evidence" as being claimed in certain quarters.

Advocate Raju Ganguly, who appeared for Mishra in court, maintained that the suspect did not perpetrate any torture on the victim and referred to the presence of "love bites" on his client's body in support of his claim.

"My client has been framed. The two had consensual sex, and there is evidence of that. There are marks of love bites on the left side of Monojit's neck.

ACCUSED MONOJIT MISHRA

PTI, KOLKATA: The Bar Council of West Bengal on Wednesday decided to expel Monojit Mishra, the prime accused in the gang rape case, from its membership and struck off his name from its rolls. The state bar council, in a special general meeting, decided to strike off Mishra's name from its rolls of advocates in view of the allegation of the heinous crime against him, its chairman Ashok Deb told reporters here. "We are all ashamed of the barbarous crime alleged to have been committed by him," he said. Deb said that the state bar council will also inform the Bar Council of India of its decision to expel Mishra from its rolls. The South Calcutta Law College had on Tuesday terminated the services of the prime accused and expelled two other students arrested in connection with the alleged gang rape of a 24-year-old first-year student on the campus.

While the judge rejected the second prayer, I am not exactly sure about what he ruled about the first," he added.

BENGALURU: A 30-year-old Infosys employee was arrested on Wednesday for allegedly "filming" a female colleague inside the women's washroom at the company's Electronic City campus, police said. The accused, identified as Swapnil Nagesh Mali, a Senior Associate Consultant from Sangli, Maharashtra, was caught by HR personnel and handed over to the police. There was no immediate response from Infosys on the incident. According to police, the incident occurred on Monday morning when the woman noticed a suspicious reflection and movement from an adjacent cubicle while using the washroom.

Rinku Lather additional district magistrate of Sepahijala will replace Chakma as the DM of Gomati district, the notification said.

BHUBANESWAR: A youth was killed by his childhood friend over a triangular love affair in Ódisha's Bolangir district, police said. The deceased has been identified as Kunja Majhi, a resident of Dumerchuan village in Kantabanji area of the district. Two persons have been apprehended in this connection, they said. According to police, Kunja was killed by his childhood friend Satya Nag and his (Satya's) associate Shankar Gharsel on June 20 night following a dispute among them. Satya was using Kunja's mobile phone to talk to his girlfriend.

Shubhanshu Shukla studies muscle loss in microgravity on board ISS

NEW DELHI: Astro-'Shux (Shukla's call sign) naut Shubhanshu Shukla is performed operations in conducting scientific experiments on board the International Space Station (ISS) to understand muscle loss under microgravity conditions, a study that could help create medicines to treat immobility among a section of the elderly. Shukla is part of the Axiom-4 private space mission to the ISS as part of a joint IS-RO-NASA initiative and docked at the orbital laboratory on

the Life Sciences Glovebox (LSG) for the myogenesis study, which could uncover how microgravity contributes to muscle loss,' Axiom Space said in a statement. It said that by identifying the molecular pathways behind skeletal muscle dysfunction, the research could lead to targeted therapies to prevent atrophy during long-duration spaceflight.
