

Goa clinch western zone title at Sri Sathya Sai Cricket League

AJMER: Goa, competing as Sai Coastal Fighter Goa, emerged champions of the Western Zone Sri Sathya Sai National Cricket League held at Presidency School, Ajmer, from June 27 to 29.

Goa's campaign was marked by commanding all-round performances. In the Super Six, they chased down 154 set by Sai Gujarat, reaching 157/7 in 19.3 overs. Rajat Shet top-scored with a rapid 46 off 24 balls, while Veer Yadav added 30. Mithil Karekar starred with

the ball, taking 4/24.

In another group match, Goa posted a formidable 222/6, powered by a blistering unbeaten 75 off 30 from Yadav. Sanath Nevagi (54) and Yash Gadekar (36) offered solid support, and Aditya Suryawanshi (3/29) led the bowling to seal a

comfortable win.

In the final, Goa piled up 230/3 after being put in to bat by Rajasthan. Ayush Verlekar led the assault with a sensational unbeaten 103 off 45 balls, while Yadav contributed 72* off 43. Rajasthan were bowled out for 173, handing Goa a

India a step away from qualification after blanking Iraq

First-half goals from Sangita Basfore and Manisha set the tone before a dominant second half saw Karthika Angamuthu, Phanjoubam Nirmala Devi, and Nongmaithem Ratanbala Devi add to the scoreline, taking India's goal tally to an impressive 22 from three games, all without conceding a single goal.

With this result, the Blue Tigresses remain unbeaten, having now claimed three wins in as many matches.

India are currently atop Group B with nine points and a goal difference of +22. With Thailand, currently second in the group, set to face Mongolia later in the day, the stage is perfectly set for a high-stakes showdown between India and Thailand on July 5. With only the group winner progressing, it will be a winner-takes-all affair.

On Wednesday, India, coming off thumping wins against Mongolia (13-0) and Timor-Leste (4-0), were high on confidence and wasted no time in asserting their authority.

Chelsea sign Brazil striker Joao Pedro from Brighton

AFP, LONDON: Chelsea signed Brazil striker Joao Pedro from Brighton in a deal worth a reported \$79 million on Wednesday.

Pedro jetted to the United States, where Chelsea are playing in the Club World Cup, on Sunday after the terms of his eight-year contract were agreed.

With the transfer now confirmed following a medical, Pedro is available to play for Enzo Maresca's side in their Club World Cup quarter-final against Palmeiras in Philadelphia.

FIFA has given clubs involved in the Club World Cup knockout phase until July 3 to register new players for the tournament.

"Everyone knows this is a big club with a great history," Pedro said.

"They had brilliant players in the past and have brilliant players now, so I am excited to join and you know when you are a Chelsea player you must think one thing - win."

Pedro, who joined Brighton for £30 million from Watford two years ago, scored 30 goals in 70 appearances for the Seagulls and has been capped three times by Brazil.

The 23-year-old missed Brighton's final two matches of the season after being dropped due to a training ground altercation with teammate Jan Paul van Hecke.
