I.N.D.I.A erupts over arrest of Kejriwal

INDIA Bloc partners AAP, Congress, CPI-M, DMK stage protest demonstration in various parts of the country; term arrest of Kejriwal as 'murder of democracy'

NAI/THIRUVANAN-THAPURAM: Enraged with the arrest of Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leader and Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal by the Enforcement Directorate in the excise policy case on Thursday, the I.N.D.I.A alliance partners staged protest demonstrations in various parts of the country against the BJP-led central government.

In his first reaction a day after his arrest, Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal has said that his life is dedicated to the nation. Responding to a question by reporters when he was being taken to court by the Enforcement Directorate, the AAP chief said in Hindi, "My life is dedicated to the country."

CPI(M), Cong protest in Kerala

Kerala on Friday witnessed widespread protests by activists of the ruling CPI(M) and the opposition Congress against the arrest of Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal by the ED, while the BJP defended the action by saying violation of the law has its consequences.

"It's up to you to make sure you do what it takes to remain safe....stay within the law. do not venture out into dark places alone at night, do not engage in drugs or excessive drinking," she said.

"The reason I'm recording
