

2 judges shot dead in Tehran

AP, DUBAI: A man fatally shot two prominent hard-line judges in Iran's capital Tehran on Saturday, officials said, both of whom allegedly took part in the mass execution of dissidents in 1988.

No group immediately claimed responsibility for the shootings of the judges, clerics Mohammad Mogheiseh and Ali Razini. However, Razini's involvement in the 1988 executions had likely made him a target in the past, including an assassination attempt in 1999.

Their killings, a rare attack targeting the judiciary, also come as Iran faces economic turmoil, the mauling of its Mideast allies by Israel, and the return of Donald Trump to the White House on Monday.

ADVENTURE TURNS INTO TRAGEDY

Pune tourist, pilot killed while paragliding at Keri

Shivani Dabale and Suman Nepali died after one of the cables snapped midway

FATAL FALL
▶▶ Shivani along with her friends had come to Goa on a holiday
▶▶ On Saturday evening, she decided to go for paragliding
▶▶ As per initial reports, one of the cables of paraglide snapped mid-air, which led to both Shivani and Suman (pilot) falling to death

▶▶ A few months back, the Keri gram sabha had passed a resolution urging the govt authorities not to permit paragliding at Keri beach
▶▶ The copies of the resolution were submitted to the departments concerned

PERNEM: A paragliding adventure turned tragic when a 26-year-old woman tourist from Pune and a 25-year-old paragliding pilot were killed after one of the cables snapped midway as the duo came crashing down at Keri-Pernem plateau on Saturday evening.

The tourist has been identified as Shivani Dabale and the paragliding pilot as Suman Nepali.

As per initial reports, one of the cables of paraglide snapped mid-air, which led

to both Shivani and Suman falling to death.

Shivani along with her friends had come to Goa for holiday. On Saturday evening she decided to go paragliding.

The Mandrem Police later conducted the panchama and sent the bodies to the Goa Medical College and Hospital (GMC), Bambolim for post-mortem examination. Further investigations are under the supervision of Mandrem PI Sherif Jacques.

Hasina says death was minutes away as she fled Bangladesh



PTI, NEW DELHI: Deposed Bangladesh prime minister Sheikh Hasina has said she and her younger sister Sheikh Rehana escaped death by just 20-25 minutes on August 5 last year when her Awami League government was toppled in a student-led mass uprising.

In a brief audio note released by her party on its Facebook page, Hasina expressed her gratitude to God for saving her life.

She also recalled two previous attempts on her life she narrowly escaped and said she believed that God had saved her life as part of a divine design to get something greater done by her.

"We escaped death by just 20-25 minutes. I feel surviving the killings on August 21, surviving the large bomb in Kotalipara, or surviving on August 5, 2024, there must be a will of Allah, the hand of Allah. Otherwise, I wouldn't have survived this time," she is heard saying in Bangla in the audio clip.

In a trembling voice, the 77-year-old leader accused her political opponents of conspiring to get her killed.

Hasina has been living in India since August 5 last year when she fled Bangladesh following a massive student-led protest that toppled her Awami League's 16-year regime.
