BENGALURU: A pall of gloom descended on Goa, as former Ponda MLA Lavoo Mamledar died shortly after an altercation with an auto driver, in Karnataka's Belagavi district on Saturday. He was 69.

Mamledar leaves behind his wife Shanti and two daughters.

It is learnt that he had gone to Belagavi and was residing in Hotel Srinivas Residency near Khade Bazaar.
