Akal Takht holds Sukhbir Badal guilty, tells him to clean toilets and serve in langar

CHANDIGARH/AMRITSAR: In a scathing indictment of the Shiromani Akali Dal (SAD) and its president Sukhbir Singh Badal, Akal Takht Jathedar Giani Raghbir Singh on Monday imposed religious punishment on Badal and other senior Akali leaders, saying they were unfit to lead the Sikh community. In an unprecedented move, the Jathedar also revoked the title of Fakhr-e-Qaum (Pride of the Nation) awarded to former Punjab Chief Minister Parkash Singh Badal. As part of the punishment, Sukhbir Badal and core committee members of the Akali Dal, including cabinet ministers from 2015, were ordered to clean toilets, serve in the langar (community kitchen), perform Nitnem (daily Sikh prayers), and recite Sukhmani Sahib. Placards were also placed around their necks as part of the sentence.

Telangana: Woman constable murdered by brother in suspected honour killing

HYDERABAD: A 29 year-old woman constable was murdered allegedly by her brother in Ibrahimpatnam near here on Monday in a suspected case of honour killing, police said. The woman's husband in a complaint to police accused her brother of killing her as he was against their inter-caste marriage, they said. Police said the accused was allegedly hatching a plan to eliminate his sister for a week "as he did not like the couple's inter-caste marriage". As part of the plan the accused also deputed a person to watch her movements and came in a car, hit her twowheeler and stabbed her on the neck, police said adding the accused has been apprehended.

Neighbour arrested over theft of Rs 1 cr, 267 sovereign gold heist in Kerala

KANNUR (KERALA): The Kerala police on Monday arrested the neighbour of a trader in connection with the theft of over Rs 1 crore and 267 sovereigns of gold, valued at approximately Rs 1.52 crore, from the latter's residence in Kannur district about two weeks ago. The accused, Lijeesh (45), was taken into custody on Saturday by an investigation team formed to probe the case, the police said. His arrest was recorded on Monday after he confessed to his crime on Sunday evening during interrogation. Kannur city police commissioner, Ajit Kumar said in a press conference that Lijeesh, a Gulf returnee, a welder by profession, carried out the theft by breaking the window of the house in Valapattanam.

Heavy rainfall continues in Tamil Nadu, Puducherry

Villupuram worst affected, Southern Railway suspends operations

PTI, VILLUPURAM: Villupuram district in north Tamil Nadu continued to reel under unprecedented flooding on Monday following extremely heavy rainfall, virtually blocking access to villages and residential colonies as bridges and roads overflowed, inundating huge acreage of standing crops and affected rail and road traffic, leaving passengers stranded.

CYCLONE FENGAL

A total of 48 trains via Villupuram were affected, and Southern Railway in the evening announced restoration of services with speed restrictions and underlined that all efforts were underway to restore all the services in the route.

Vehichles swept away in flooded Uthangarai area following heavy rainfall in the aftermath of Cyclone Fengal in Krishnagiri district, Tamil Nadu, on Monday

Vehicles were submerged up to two feet and the roads came completely under water in several parts of Villupuram, and nearby Cuddalore, where residents were stunned by the flooding. River Thenpennai was

in spate, trees were uprooted in several areas and electricity poles were tilted. Several houses, particularly tiled tenements, at Aragandanallur in Villupuram were almost submerged with water level rising over 4 feet.

Parts of Krishnagiri and Dharmapuri districts, in west Tamil Nadu, too witnessed floods unseen in the past two decades. Uthangarai in Krishnagiri district received a whopping 50 cm rainfall, Villupuram district received upto 42 cm, and Harur in Dharmapuri received 33 cm. Cuddalore and Tiruvannamalai recorded 16 cm, and all of which was from 8.30 am on December 1 to 8.30 am, on the following day. In Villupu-

ram district alone, 3,617 persons have been housed in 65 relief shelters and 15 disaster relief teams are operational

Many vehicles, including cars and vans were dragged by floods from a road at Uthangarai into low-lying area, shocking people.

Several of the vehicles were owned by local tour operators. Road access from Uthangarai to towns such as Krishnagiri and Tiruvannamalai has been affected due to heavy inundation.

A senior India Meteorological Department official here told PTI that the extremely heavy rainfall was due to the presence of remnants of Cyclone Fengal in land areas. On the night of November 30, the cyclonic storm made the landfall near Puducherry.

With water rising above the danger level on an arterial bridge between Vikravandi and Mundiyampakkam in Villupuram, Southern Railway on Monday morning suspended operations in that key stretch, leading to cancellations, diversion and short termination of services, which includes express and superfast trains.

Several opposition leaders, who attended the meeting, also echoed Rijiju's views about Parliament functioning smoothly from Tuesday. Asked about other issues

being raised by the opposition such as the Sambhal violence and the unrest in Manipur, Rijiju said Birla has made it clear that any matter can be raised in line with the rules, while requesting parties to allow Parliament to function smoothly.

Farmers' 'Delhi Chalo' march on land compensation stopped in Noida ganisation of 12 farmers'

PTI, NEW DELHI/ NOIDA: Farmers from different parts of Uttar Pradesh demanding adequate compensation for their lands acquired by the government marched towards Delhi on Monday but were stopped at the Noida-Delhi border where they sat on a dharna. The farmers said if their demands were not met within seven days, they would again march towards

Delhi. Raising slogans of "Bol Kisan, Halla Bol", the protesting farmers gathered at the Mahamaya flyover on the Dadri-Noida link road and began their 'Delhi Chalo' march around 11:30 am.

Massive traffic snarls caused inconvenience to commuters crossing the Delhi-Noida borders as police set up multiple layers of barricades and deployed heavy security to stop the march, which coincided with Parlia-

ment's Winter Session. Bumper-to-bumper traffic was witnessed at Noida's Chilla border for several hours as the protesters, waving banners and flags of various farmer groups, crossed the initial barricades.

They finally stopped near Dalit Prerna Sthal, around a kilometre from the Chilla border, an entry point to Delhi, where

senior police officers tried to pacify them.

Traffic on the stretch resumed around 6 pm after the protesting farmers gave a week's time to fulfil their various demands, including the payment of land acquisition dues, as mandated by the Land Acquisition Act, 2013.

bodies — said the farmers had decided to stay at Dalit Prerana Sthal for the time being following assurances from the authorities that the chief secretary would meet to "discuss and settle their demands".

"The Yogi Adityanath government has failed to ensure justice to the farmers. The BJP-led Uttar Pradesh government has not revised the land circle rate since 2017 and landowners have been denied adequate, lawful compensation and other benefits assured by the Land Acquisition Act, 2013," it said.
