

India eves play Uzbek in two friendlies

PTI, NEW DELHI: The Indian senior women's team will play two FIFA international friendly matches against Uzbekistan in the May/June window, the All-India Football Federation (AIFF) said on Thursday.

The two matches against Uzbekistan will be played on May 30 and June 3 at the Padukone-Dravid Centre for Sports Excellence in Bengaluru.

The Blue Tigresses, coached by Crispin Chettri, are preparing for the AFC Women's Asian Cup 2026 Qualifiers, having begun their camp in Bengaluru on May 1.

India have been drawn in Group B, where they are set to face Mongolia (June 23), Timor-Leste (June 29), Iraq (July 2), and hosts Thailand (July 5), in Chiang Mai.

India, who are at 69th position in the FIFA Women's Rankings, have played Uzbekistan, ranked 50th,

The 19-year-old has played 33 T20s and scored 911 runs with

"He will join RR for his base price of Rs 30 Lakh," said the IPL in a statement.
