Bhutani project's future rests with TCP: Dy Speaker

VASCO: Deputy Speaker and Mormugao Planning and Development Authority (MPDA) chairman Joshua D'Souza has stated that the decision to revoke permissions granted to the controversial Bhutani project in Sancoale rests with the Town and Country Planning (TCP) Department.
