54 illegal structures in Old Goa heritage zone

Tiswadi Mamlatdar's report identifies structures belonging to former minister and panchayat functionaries; all eyes now on High Court

PANJIM: The heritage precincts of Old Goa, declared a UNESCO World Heritage Site back in 1986 and containing multiple monuments of national importance like Se Cathedral and Bom Jesus, has 54 illegal structures within the prohibited zone, including buildings reportedly belonging to former minister Pandurang Madkaikar and village panchayat functionaries.

This shocking fact has come to light in a survey by Tiswadi Mamlatdar Kaushik Dessai and the survey report has been submitted to the High Court of Bombay at Goa, which is hearing a PIL by John Baptista Mascarenhas of Ponda, who had approached the court for action against illegal encroachments and commercial activities in prohibited areas around the Old Goa world heritage monuments. directed that action on illegal structures would be taken after the Mamlatdar submitted the report.

The State government has passed a notification regulating any development within the prohibited area and extending up to 200 metres of the prohibited area as notified under the Ancient Monuments and Archaeological Sites and Remains Act, 1958. Thus, an NOC from the Archaeological Survey of India is mandatory under
