3 terrorists killed in encounter with security forces in J&K

PTI, SRINAGAR: Three terrorists were killed on Saturday following an overnight gunbattle with security forces in Jammu and Kashmir's Baramulla district, officials said, terming it as a "significant success" ahead of the assembly elections.

Briefing the media after the operation in Chak Tapper Kreeri in the Pattan area of the north Kashmir district, Commander of the Army's 10 Sector Rashtriya Rifles Brigadier Sanjay Kannoth said that security forces had been receiving inputs about the movement of terrorists in Kreeri.

"Last night, we received

specific intelligence from intelligence agencies about the presence of some unidentified terrorists in Chak

Tapar/Watargam," he said, adding that a cordon was established at the suspected location.

"Our columns were fired upon by the terrorists hiding in a disused building. As per the standard operating procedures, we returned the fire. The location was cordoned and reinforcements were inducted," Brig Kannoth said.

He said the terrorists continued with incessant heavy firing on the troops throughout the night which was effectively countered.

"The operation continued in the morning when our troops in a very professional manner engaged the terrorists and neutralised them without any collateral damage to civilian life and property," the army officer added.

In the operation, three "hardcore" terrorists were neutralised and a large quantity of war-like stores were recovered, Brig Kannoth said, adding that the identity of the terrorists is yet to be ascertained.

The officer said keeping in view the forthcoming sensitive events in the UT, "this operation assumes significant importance and is a notable success for the security forces and a disruption of nefarious Pakistani design in the Kashmir Valley".

Campaigning is on in Jammu and Kashmir for the three-phase Assembly elections which are being held after 10 years.

Mobile net to be suspended in Assam today for govt recruitment exam

PTI, GUWAHATI: The Assam government on Saturday ordered suspension of mobile internet services across the state for three-and-half hours from 10 am on September 15 during a written examination for recruitment to Grade III posts.

Voice calls and broadband connectivity based on fixed telephone lines will remain functional, it added.

The notification, signed by Ajay Tewari, additional chief secretary, Home and Political department, said it has been issued "in the interest of holding free, fair and transparent public examination and also to prevent arising of any law and order issues having bearing on public safety".

Mobile Internet/ mobile data/ mobile wi-fi services in the entire state will remain suspended from 10 am to 1.30 pm on Sunday.

"It is however clarified that the voice calls and the broadband connectivity based on fixed telephone lines may remain functional during the aforesaid period," the notification said.

People offer food, umbrellas to agitating doctors; thousands treated at free 'Abhaya' clinic

PTI, KOLKATA: Forty-year-old Arpan Maity, a practising physician and an alumnus of R G Kar Medical College and Hospital, was busy collecting food items, clothes, raincoats, umbrellas and other materials at a makeshift counter near the state health department headquarters where thousands of medics have been staging a sit-in for the last five days.

From cots, bed sheets and raincoats to large umbrellas and food packets, the agitators are flooded with items from common people, Maity told PTI at the agitation site.

"Till 2 pm on Saturday, 3,000 food packets have been served for free to people, not only

to the protesters but also to local hawkers, rickshaw-pullers, autorickshaw drivers, journalists and other those who have come to the site to express solidarity with the movement," he said.

Prajakta Sikdar, another volunteer who is dividing her time between raising slogans and manning one

of the four counters at the protest site, said that till 1.30 pm on Saturday, she had distributed around 600 vegetarian food packets among the people.

"Please don't hesitate... Tell me what you want, we have prepared all these packets for you. If you want to have cakes or other refreshments, that

is also available," she was heard telling a person.

A taxi driver was seen unloading hundreds of packets of food from the vehicle's boot, while three people in another vehicle were seen bringing folding cots to the site.

"A well-wisher, who is a teacher of an English medium school in Sodepur, has sent these 400 food packets but she can't identify herself," the taxi driver said while offering a packet to this correspondent.

Dibyendu Banerjee, a junior doctor manning the 'Abhaya' Clinic, which has been set up to treat patients at the site, said that till now 350 people, including policemen, have been treated.

HIMACHAL MOSQUE DISPUTE

The bandh call till 11 AM given by the VHP and various business groups saw protest marches by some Hindu organisations at Bilaspur, Kullu, Chamba, Hamirpur, Poanta Sahib and other places. There was not much impact in Shimla as the Beopar Mandal had already observed a bandh on Thursday.

The protesters also recited Hanuman chalisa during the bandh period in Hamirpur and Chamba towns and raised slogans.

The protest was against unauthorised construction of a portion of a mosque in Shimla and encroachment on government land by a mosque in Mandi besides baton charge on protesters of Hindu groups in Shimla on Wednesday and use of water cannon on demonstrators in Mandi on Friday, VHP officer bearers said.

The protesters are also demanding verification of outsiders living in the state.

"The Manali Beopar Mandal kept the shops closed for two hours," said Rajneesh, general

secretary Manali Beopar Mandal Rajneesh.

Shops also remained closed in Dalhousie. Proper verification of outsiders should be done and encroachments should be dealt strictly, said a shopkeeper of Dalhousie.

Ten people including four police personnel were injured in the clash between the police and the protesters in Sanjauli area of Shimla town on Wednesday and FIRs have been registered against 50 people by the police.

"There have been several incidents of Muslims taking laws in hands in Chamba and we have been strongly advocating for verification of outsiders for a long time," said VHP state president Keshav Verma.
