Festive cheer: Beef relief for Goans, supply resumes today

Vendors meet CM, South Goa Collector seeking protection from cow vigilante groups; shops left with limited stock due to supply shortage from across borders

MARGAO: There was something to cheer for beef consumers in the State after a two-day 'total' blackout. as they received a major reprieve on Christmas Eve with the All Goa Beef Traders' Association announcing that the vendors will resume operations from December 25.

The decision comes after a two-day closure, which caused significant inconvenience to consumers and businesses, especially during the festive season.

Following the closure, beef traders had raised concerns citing security issues. After meeting Chief Minister Pramod Sawant on
